Council Meeting Minutes - December 2005

- Meeting was called to order by VP Jack Richards at 6:30 pm Officers in attendance were VP Jack Richards, President Wallace Bow, Secretary Suzanne Monroy, Treasurer Lori Jordan, Activities Director Stu Gorelick, CIA David Judd, editor Phil Ellison and Activities-elect Larry Osborne.
- This was the final Council Meeting of 2005 with existing elected officers. New officers will be announced at the Awards Banquet 12/10; term of office begins 1/1/06.
- Activities Director elect Larry Osborne asked for ideas for Club activities for 2006; how far into 2006 should he set up the events calendar (Ron Scott has NCCC sanctioned events dates for coordination); how to setup a club email address accessible to all members for disbursing information.
- Pres. Wallace Bow shared that he has 9 dates setup for Sandia Motor Sports for 2006; some
 autocross/some race dates. He and VP Jack Richards plan to meet with management at Sandia re:
 track availability and setup for the 2006 SWI. In addition Wallace offered to contact other car clubs in
 the area to setup Corvette vs. challenges. Also, the club will check with Route 66 casino to find out
 the opening date of the new convention/hotel center for a possible site for SWI events.
- Activities Director Stu Gorelick mentioned that the Awards Banquet will be held @ County Line Restaurant; 7 pm for socializing and 8 pm for dinner (cost is \$28/person). The event will be held in a private room, there will be prizes, awards, the tire raffle (deadline for claiming the tires will be 1/20/06) and great company!
- Watch for an email inviting everyone to a New Year's Eve party being hosted by Hugh and Suzanne Monroy (please RSVP to their email address).
- CIA David Judd announced the winners of the Club competition points; prizes to be awarded at the Awards Banquet.
- Helga Judd has graciously offered to pick up and mail our monthly newsletter. The Judds will pay for the cost of printing from Staples (approximately 85-120 copies/month); the Club will reimburse them.
 There will be an option to not receive a hard copy of the newsletter.
- Lori Jordan shared that Governor Ron Scott said the Club has the required 51% NCCC membership
 to receive NCCC benefits. She also stated that the Club president appoints someone to handle
 membership; this person also handles any press releases and forwarding of articles to publications
 such as Blue Bars. In addition, the Activities Director is responsible for gathering photos for the

 and have the opportunity to snap photos, all members are encouraged to submit photos taken.

- Webmaster & editor Phil Ellison stated that the Club competition points should be posted to the
 website & newsletter quarterly. Phil presented David Judd with membership information and other
 paperwork required to carry on with the monthly newsletter distribution.
- VP Jack Richards brought some issues to the Council for discussion including setting up an annual budget for the Club to follow for 2006 and how to increase membership rolls.
- The next Council meeting will be @ 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, 1/10 @ Sandia Computers on Wyoming; all members are welcome to attend.
- The next general meeting is @ 7 p.m. on Friday, 1/20 @ CASA Chevrolet. The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 by VP Jack Richards.
