Minutes: January 25, 2006

President **Bob Agnew** brought the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Joyce Clements took the floor to give a short talk about liability insurance in place of Carolyn Waterman from Hagerty Insurance. Carolyn Waterman was unable to attend due to weather problems. She was going to talk about a blanket liability policy to cover all the car clubs in the council and all their activities. Carolyn's position was that trying to design a general policy that would cover every club and their activities would be too complicated and her advice was for each club to contact an insurance representative to see about getting a policy written to cover their specific needs and that a Hagerty agent could help them find the best coverage.

Ron Rymarz then gave a Treasurer's Report-We have a balance of \$5532.01 in our checking account as of this date.

Old Business: **Jon Doran** reported that he is still working with students and faculty over at UNM to design a council web site. He reported that such a web site when completed would cost about \$115.40 to maintain on an annual basis.

Joyce Clements also talked about web sites. She looked into the matter and found that Hemmings Motor News will provide us with a free web site. She also checked with a professional about designing and setting up a web site. Once up and running the cost of maintaining that web site would be around \$700 on an annual basis.

Jon Doran took the floor next to talk about City Nuisance Ordinances and how the city keeps expanding the criteria for which a property can be declared a nuisance. He advises that we keep informed about nuisance matters that come before the city council otherwise the council's actions might be detrimental to our interests in the future.

Albuquerque Museum Car Show-Will be held on May 21, 2006. The Corvair Club of NM has volunteered to run this event. **Joyce Clements** made a motion that we increase the entry fee for this show to \$10 per car to cover our costs. The motion was seconded and passed. **Bill Lemen** asked if the city of Albuquerque was going to get involved this year as part of their Tri-Centennial observances.

Bob Agnew spoke about the need for a volunteer to run the Annual Swap Meet in September. No volunteer stepped forward but the club reps asked if they could table this measure so that they could discuss the matter with their members. So this matter was tabled until our next meeting.

All Club's Picnic-Is tentatively scheduled for August 6, 2006 and the Firebird Club has volunteered to run this event.

Volunteers Luncheon-No date set but **Bill Lemen** volunteered to set up and run this event again this year.

Ron Rymarz-Our Treasurer, presented the council a budget for 2006. According to his figures the council's expected income for this year will be about \$8500. And our costs for running all our council events for 2006 are expected to be approximately \$7500.

At this point a motion was made that we adjourn this meeting. The motion was seconded and voted on and the meeting was closed.
