**CORVETTE TRIVIA ANSWERS**

- ☀ A grand total of 4 Corvettes left the factory painted black in 1954 (hardly seems worth loading the sprayer!)
- ☀ Chrome shift knobs were common for the early production run of the 1957 Corvette.
- ☀ \$16.15 was the high price to be paid in order to drive around in a two-tone 1959 Corvette.
- ☀ The 327 cid engine went into the 1962 Corvette for the first time. If you were wanting power, the macho 360 hp fuel injected 327 cid would cost you another \$484.20....a sizeable sum in 1962.
