### MUSEUM CAR SHOW

We had a good show this year. There were 341 paid registrations and about a dozen stationary engine displays that didn't register or pay. Pre-registered clubs handled their own parking, and most of that went smoothly. There were a few misunderstandings about the tickets necessary to enter and park with your group, but most of the pre-paid participants did well with the new system; we will work on smoothing out the bumps for next year. The Council put out more money for advertising than in the past, and we seemed to have more spectators. The weather was really nice; there were lots and lots of beautiful vehicles on display. Then the rains came. Some headed for home, but after about 15 minutes, the awards were handed out. Results are elsewhere in this newsletter. A preliminary balance shows us to be ahead about \$450, but a couple of bills and the Volunteer Lunch-eon are still to be paid for. We will probably come out about even money-wise this time.
