Old Business:

Car Show Wrap Up Report- **Joyce Clements** reported that we had 318 paid entries in our Albuquerque Museum Car Show and that we received a lot of compliments about the car show. Our volunteer luncheon will be held on July 27, 2008 at Village Pizza in Corrales. Lunch for volunteers will be free but guests will be charged for their meal.

Web Site Report- **Michael Maestas** spoke about the layout of our new web site and that our set up criteria has been sent to the web site company. Lead time is 2 to 3 weeks for set up and the new web site should be up and running in about a month. **John Doran** has volunteered to provide web site training for those who want to learn the ins and outs of working around this new system.

New Business:

All Clubs Picnic- **Sid Sommers**, Route 66 Rodders Club, reported that we will be in the same location at Villanueva State Park as we were last year. The club has checked with rangers at the park and they said that no open fires will be allowed on the site due to fire restrictions. So we will need to supply gas grilles and propane tanks to cook on. Hot dogs and hamburgers will be on the menu. These items, paper products, and other incidentals will be supplied by the Route 66 Rodders.
