Bennie Martinez of the Viper Club was introduced as another guest and he spoke about a charity event that his club is hosting on April 26, 2009. This event called the "2009 Roadrunner Fun Run" is being held to raise funds for the Marine Corps Law Enforcement Association. Everyone is invited to attend and participate. Entry fee is \$25.00, and registration starts at the Double Eagle Airport at 10:00AM. The poker run starts at 11:00 and should last between 3 1/2-4 hours.

Old Business:

John Doran gave a Legislative Report update on some of the bills that were automobile related that were introduced during this session. "Front License Plate" bill was not voted on by the general body because it never made it out of committee. So we won't have to go through the bureaucratic mess with mvd that might have happened had this bill been passed. The "Classic Car Appreciation Bill" suffered the same fate, never making it out of committee screening.

New Business:

"Budget Proposal for 2009": Our council budget for last year was around \$13,700 and we discussed coming up with a budget for the current year. The proposed budget for this year and the events it covers are as follows: Albuquerque Museum Car Show \$3500.00, Annual Swap Meet \$4000.00, All Clubs Picnic (Plan A) Hot dogs and hamburgers (if we are allowed to cook over an open flame) \$485.00 & (Plan B) (no fires allowed) Cold cuts for sandwiches \$190.00, Covered Shelter Area Fee \$130.00.

Treasurer's Report: **Ron Rymarz** reports that as of this date our checking account balance stood at \$7426.38.

Joyce Clements announced that there would be an Albuquerque Museum Car Show Committee meeting on Wednesday night, April 1, 2009 at the Merrill Lynch Building on Louisiana and everyone was invited to attend.

At this point the meeting was brought to a close.
