Treasurer's Report: **Ron Rymarz** reports that our checking account balance as of this date stood at \$5234.50 and that we have almost \$14,000 in certificates of deposit.

Old Business:

Web Site: **Joyce Clements** reports that she and **Michael Maestas** are still working on trying to eliminate some system bugs. Progress is being made however because now we can post flyers on our web site and we also have photos up on the web site as well.

Car Show: **Joyce Clements** spoke about our Albuquerque Museum Car Show. We had 362 vehicles on display and the museum reports that we had as high as 10,000 people show up to look at our cars and trucks. We took in \$3620.00 in entry fees and had \$600 left over after our expenses were paid.

Volunteer Luncheon: **Joyce Clements** announced that a Volunteer Luncheon for all those who helped out during the car show will be held on July 12, 2009 starting at 12:00 noon at Mario's Pizza in the North Valley. Go north on 4th Street and just past the intersection of Montano, (a block north) you'll see Gene Street on your right. Turn right and you are there. Bring your old cars, parking lot can hold about 70 cars.

Kudos: **Bob Agnew** reported that Cuidando Los Ninos gave us a nice write-up in their newsletter thanking us for our support through the "Annual Spring Thaw" at Worldwide Automotive.

New Business:

Swap Meet Committee- Met with the Los Lunas Chamber of Commerce today to discuss us using the facilities at Morris Field in Los Lunas for our Annual Swap Meet in late September. This was the first meeting and topics were discussed about how we can run another successful event at that location. More meetings will be held as the event draws closer.
