The bill about 2 license plates, HB305, is currently in the Taxation & Revenue Committee. It got a "Do Pass" recommendation from the Transportation & Public Works Committee. Legislative Report: **Michael Maestas** and **John Doran** reported on car-related bills presently proceeding through the legislature. One of the bills they discussed was the "Front License Plate" proposal which seems to have some support in both the house and the senate. Practically everyone on hand wondered why there was support for a proposal that didn't make any sense. Both **John** and **Michael** advised people to contact their representatives to let them know where they stand on this issue. Both suggested that if people contact their representatives they do so in a respectable manner, so that we don't alienate our elected officials.

Michael Maestas also wanted to thank all our club members that participated in the Supernationals Show by providing a vehicle for our New Mexico Council of Car Clubs Display.

New Business: **Joyce Clements** announced that we have a new club in our fold. This new club is called Valley Vintage Car Club of Roswell. **Joyce Clements** also asked for volunteers to help work on the Albuquerque Museum Car Show Committee and a number of people heeded her call by stepping up and volunteering to help out.
