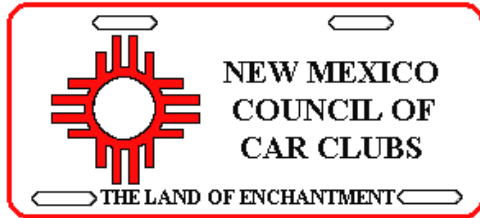

SWAP MEET REPORT

We sold just at 400 spaces; a couple of vendors took their paper work with them, and we think the total was 402. We spent more money on advertising and security this year, plus we spent money on two-way radios and tents. Paint supplies were more expensive, as were postage, printing and other supplies. We still have a couple of outstanding bills, but the estimated profits look to be about \$3,450.00, before any payment to Los Lunas for the use of the field. This is about \$800.00 less gain than 2008, but the tents, radios and and paint sprayers we purchased will be used in the future. An exact balance sheet will be available as soon as all expenses are settled.

NOTE: This money covers operating expenses for the Council. We pay for insurance, post office box rent, newsletter publication, web site, and the All Clubs Picnic. The Council charges no annual dues to offset costs, so we need to make sure we make enough from our swap meet to cover all expenses.
