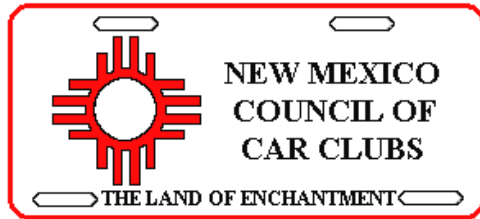

Bob Agnew introduced our guests and let them speak about subjects they wished to present to the council. **Ray Wilkinson**, from Bob Turner Ford, spoke about car shows they wanted to host at their dealership in May. They are offering \$200.00 per club appearance money. **Ray** passed out his business cards and encouraged all Ford clubs to participate.

Robert Jacobs spoke about an idea that he had about presenting a car award and a stipend every year at our Annual Albuquerque Museum Car Show. This award would be presented to an individual for outstanding excellence in restoring a 1960 and earlier vehicle. **Robert Jacobs** would put up his own money in an escrow account for this award and he would like a car council committee to choose who to give this award to on an annual basis. He said if we were interested in accepting his offer we could work out the details later. **Chuck Logan** made a motion that we accept his offer. **James Clements** also made a motion that if we accept his offer we would have to change our 501C-7 tax status to a 501C-3. Both motions were seconded and passed.

Treasurer's Report: **Ron Rymarz** reports that our checking account balance as of this date stands at \$5191.53.

Storage Unit Progress: **Dennis Seibert** reports that the storage unit will be ready to accept our council items on May 7, 2010.

And a suggestion was made that we prepare a nice thank you/appreciation letter for David for all the work and trouble he has gone through to get our web site up and running.

The fee for the event will be \$5 per car, payable on entry. Some camping spots are available for overnights; fees are being negotiated on those. All reps are reminded to invite the members of their respective clubs.

The last topic up for discussion was the support of Council events by member clubs. The Council reps need to emphasize the importance of these events to their members. Clubs should keep the dates in mind when planning their yearly calendars and try to avoid conflicting events on the same day.
