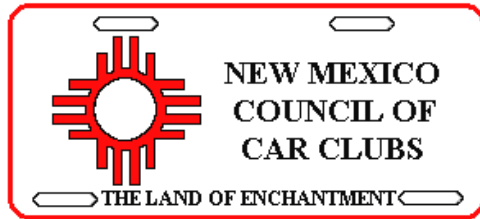

They are offering \$200.00 per club appearance money. **Ray** passed out his business cards and encouraged all Ford clubs to participate.

**Robert Jacobs** spoke about an idea that he had about presenting a car award and a stipend every year at our Annual Albuquerque Museum Car Show. Both motions were seconded and passed.

Storage Unit Progress: **Dennis Seibert** reports that the storage unit will be ready to accept our council items on May 7, 2010.
