**BY-LAWS/501c-3 COMMITTEE MEETING**

On October 13, **Lisa Bon Durant, Bill Lemen, Lauri Rector, and Jim, Joyce & Will Clements** met to discuss necessary changes to the Council by-laws. Some modifications need to be made to comply with the proposed 501C-3 tax status. The IRS has specific rules governing this status. Since the by-laws were last updated in 1988, we have added electronic mailings, created a web site, and added a newsletter position. No provisions or definitions for these are in the current by-laws. Our growing membership also makes some other changes desirable. The group proposed a number of changes to coincide with our way of conducting business. The changes will be presented next January, as some legal items must be checked before inclusion. The proposals will be discussed at the October meeting.
