Treasurer's Report- **Ron Rymarz** reported that our checking account balance as of this date stands at \$6377.47. And that we have taken in \$2500.00 so far in Swap Meet pre-registrations.

Old Business-

All Clubs' Picnic- **Dennis Seibert** talked about all those members who didn't attend our Annual All Clubs Picnic at Nambé Falls missed a great time. 113 cars showed up and we fed 250 people. We also raised \$803.00 in donations for the Ronald McDonald House Charities and a number of nice door prizes were handed out during the day. The Rainbow Road Runners Club has volunteered to host next year's picnic and they are talking about having the event at the same place.

Rio Grande Compound Neighborhood Association Car Show and Breakfast-**Paul McLaughlin** reported that this event drew 17 cars and there were plenty of food and drinks available for all those who participated in this event. He read a letter of appreciation from the Rio Grande Compound Neighborhood Association along with a \$100.00 check for our treasury.

New Business-

Annual Fall Swap Meet- **Joyce Clements** reported that we have pre-sold over 164 spaces so far and that the food vendors have been signed up. She passed around a volunteer sign up sheet for people to help out on Saturday and Sunday. **John Hayne** has submitted his design for the collector/vendor pins and these should be available at our next meeting for all to see. A request was made for people to look into tents for people to eat under.

501C-3 Status Change For the Council- **Lisa BonDurant** spoke about this subject and gave us more details on what is involved in trying to change our status from a 501C-7 to a 501C-3 for reporting to the IRS. Basically she said that in our reports the IRS wants to know how we receive our funds, how we spend those funds and that no council reps or officers are receiving any compensation or perks from these funds. She also spoke about the need of changing our fiscal year dates and our election dates to coincide with fiscal year reporting dates of January 1 through December 31, or July 1 through June 30. And to change those dates we may have to change our By-Laws. To look into changing our By-Laws it was suggested that a committee be formed to look into this matter and the following people volunteered to serve on that committee: **Bill Lemen**, **Joyce Clements**, **Lisa BonDurant**, **Lauri Rector**, and **Bob Agnew**. **Lisa** also reported that there would be a fee of \$800.00 to change our status to a 501C-3. Further discussion of this matter was tabled until the October or November meeting.

On a side note **Lisa** also suggested that any non profit clubs in the car council might want to go to the IRS web site to make sure that their club name doesn't appear on a list of non-compliance for not having submitted the proper forms to the IRS on their Non Profit Status. It is relatively easy to check this list and file the proper form electronically to come into compliance thus insuring that they will maintain their Non Profit Status eligibility.

Web Site Update- **David Pachak-Robie** reported that our web site is up and running and that everything seems to be working okay.
