Treasurer's Report-**Ron Rymarz** reports that as of this date we have a checking account balance of \$9481.92

Old Business-Any Events Attended-**Joyce Clements** reports that they went to St. George, Utah for an Early Ford V-8 Meet and had a great time. About 200 cars and 725 people showed up for this event.

New Business-Swap Meet Report- **Joyce Clements** reports that we spent about \$4393.16 on this event and we took in \$8929.23. We had a good turnout and lots of happy vendors. All told we sold 403 spaces. And it was suggested that we send a thank you note to the Village of Los Lunas and a check for \$1000.00. Then a motion was made to send a donation of \$1250.00 to the Village of Los Lunas to thank them for letting us use Morris Field for this event. Our Treasurer, **Ron Rymarz**, stood up and objected to us sending a donation to Los Lunas because he felt we should be building up our Treasury rather than depleting it by donating funds. He felt that we are spending too much money every year putting on our three major events, and if we are not careful we are going to go broke. A heated discussion followed where suggestions were made to raise Swap Meet Space fees and to cut the number of classes and trophies at the Albuquerque Museum Car Show next year to cut costs. A suggestion was also made that we consider dropping the All Clubs Picnic every year because it was starting to cost us too much to put on an event of this nature. In order to bring the discussion to a close it was decided that the New Mexico Council of Car Clubs' Board will meet early in January of 2011 to discuss these issues and to make suggestions to council members at the regular January meeting as to how we can resolve these issues.

By Laws Changes-**Lisa BonDurant** says that we will discuss By Laws changes at our January 2011 meeting.

Dennis Seibert made a motion to thank **Lisa BonDurant** and **David Pachak-Robie** for all the help they have given us over the last year in working on the By-Laws and fixing our website so we can use it.
