On July 6, Governor **Susana Martinez** proclaimed that July 8, 2011 would be recognized as "Collector Car Appreciation Day" in the state of New Mexico. In Albuquerque, Mayor **R J Berry**, endorsed an event to celebrate the occasion. The New Mexico Council of Car Clubs (www.nmcarcouncil.org) organized an Albuquerque event and officially celebrated the day with an old-fashioned cruise down Historic Route 66 (Central Avenue). At the end of the ride, participants were welcomed to a hot dog and hamburger roast at Mild to Wild Classics automotive shop. The parking lot and garage were filled with a host of collector automobiles. **Tony Kos** and the **Rickshaws Car Club** have a big THANK YOU due for arranging this. NMCCC President **Dennis Seibert** interrupted the music long enough to introduce **Doug Lutz**, representing the mayor's office. **Mr. Lutz** welcomed everyone to the celebration, and affirmed the mayor's (and the city's) enthusiastic support of the hobby.
