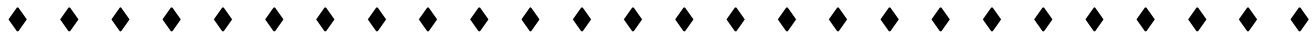
**New Business:** Members are encouraged to visit the SEMA web site and voice your opinion on a proposed EPA ruling to increase ethanol to 15% in gas.
