In 2013, E15 (15% ethanol) gas was mandated. There was a bill in both houses of Congress to modify its implementation. That was in April of 2013. Does anyone out there know the status of E15 gas at the current time? I have been unable to find any action taken since then. The E-15 will work in many new cars, but will harm many older vehicles.

**Ethanol-Free Gas:** There are 23 stations in New Mexico that sell ethanol-free gas, and over 7,000 stations nation-wide. To find a list, go to [www.pure-gas.org](http://www.pure-gas.org) and click on the desired state. This is a good resource for older cars that don't like the gasohol too well.

I apologize up front for using this forum, but I have to say I am somewhat dismayed how anyone in the car hobby can think Gary King is well intentioned by this legislation. I agree that there are unscrupulous dealers, and that people fall prey to those individuals. Gary King should focus his attention on those particular instances on a case by case basis, instead of trying to kill flies with a bazooka. There are, or should be, laws on the books to protect individuals from those scammers. This over-reach by the Attorney General sounds like a Bonanza for suit-happy attorneys. I've been to three meetings on this, and nobody can answer this question. What if the person I sell my car to abuses it for three months, then decides to come back at me cause it quit running? What recourse do I have? I think this is a slippery slope, although the common retort is that it doesn't effect you because you don't sell more than 4 cars. These kinds of laws move incrementally. Think of that Lobster in the Pot.

We then moved to an update on the car show. We are set with posters and plaques celebrating 75 years of Mercury. We will also be featuring 50 years of Mustang and GTO.
