In 2013, E15 (15% ethanol) gas was mandated. There was a bill in both houses of Congress to modify its implementation. That was in April of 2013. Does anyone out there know the status of E15 gas at the current time? I have been unable to find any action taken since then. The E-15 will work in many new cars, but will harm many older vehicles.

**Ethanol-Free Gas:** There are 23 stations in New Mexico that sell ethanol-free gas, and over 7,000 stations nation-wide. To find a list, go to [www.pure-gas.org](http://www.pure-gas.org) and click on the desired state. This is a good resource for older cars that don't like the gasohol too well.

Polk which was a United States Submarine first commissioned in 1965. The portion of the submarine that is being restored and will be on display at the museum is the sail that you see out of the water when the sub is partially submerged. The volunteers have been grinding old paint, preparing for the repainting process. What they would like help with is filling in low spots in the sail left by the old paint removal and grinding process.
