

each car will now face intense scrutiny upon trade in.

It's a reality of the regulation that has even the governor of New Mexico concerned. "My concern is that when you go to trade in a car, it's going to be of less value because they're going to have to spend money to insure that the car has never been damaged in any way," Gov. Susana Martinez said. Car dealers, along with Martinez, anticipate used cars in New Mexico will be shipped to cities like El Paso, Dallas, Phoenix and Denver, where they will not be subject to such strict inspections. But that could deplete the New Mexico market of used cars, forcing the inventory left behind to cost the public much more. The governor is among those concerned that the regulation will drive up prices, shut down dealerships and take jobs and money to outlying states like Texas, Arizona and Colorado.

Consumer Attorney Rick Feferman in Albuquerque says car dealers are generally "liars" and "greedy." Feferman, whose records indicate he has sued almost every car dealership in New Mexico says, "If they would just be honest in the first place, they would put me out of business." Feferman says he directly contributed to the wording of the statewide regulation by submitting his suggestions as part of the public input process for the regulation. He says he has no special arrangement with the Attorney General's Office to take consumer cases related to the auto industry. Nevertheless, the Attorney General has issued a delay for the state agency to begin enforcing the regulation until August. However, the regulation stipulates that private attorneys can proceed with lawsuits under the new regulation retroactively to the beginning of this month.
