MINUTES OF NM CAR COUNCIL GENERAL MEETING – May 27, 2015

President **Dennis** called us to order at 7:35.

The Council welcomed **Lyle Ferrell** of the New Mexico Jaguar Club, a new member as of this date.

Treasurer's report shows a positive balance, and we are collecting a miniscule amount of interest on the CD's.

The Car Show at the Museum was a success, and we have a slight positive balance. Two bills are not in yet: Museum admissions and Volunteer Lunch are still to be paid. A list of volunteers eligible for the pizza lunch was passed for editing. The lunch will be free for the people who helped at the show and \$10 for guests.

Web Master, **Robert Gold**, reported 1400 "hits" on the web site events page, a good sign that many people are finding the site. He cited a need to make some changes to make sure we have current information on clubs; We need to require a renewal at least once a year from each club if they wish to remain on the web site. He also stated a need to have a back-up person that knows how to update the web site in case he becomes unable to do so. **Jamie Saavedra** volunteered to get with him and learn the access for updating. **Jamie** also reported that we have 863 "likes" on facebook. She and **Robert** have been posting flyers for events.

The Great Race will be at the Unser Museum on June 24. 117 cars are expected, and a number of hobbyists will be there to greet them. **Lauri Rector, Su Rymarz** and **Joyce Clements** are collecting materials for a goody bag for each driver, welcoming them to Albuquerque. The City actually provided some monogrammed bags and Albuquerque visitors' guides. We also have Albuquerque Museum information, Route 66 maps and magazines, dash plaques, and NM Railroad Historical Society contributions. When other volunteers were asked for, there was silence. The nominations were closed, and ballots will be mailed to Active Member Clubs.

Perry Key brought a drawing he had made of the late **James Vigil's** 1947 Chevrolet that **James** owned for many, many years. **Perry** invited anyone who wished to write a note to do so. The picture and notes will be presented to **James'** widow, **Gloria**, in memory of his love of all old cars.
