IMPORTANT CAR SHOW INFORMATION

The Albuquerque Museum is opening an exhibit about Route 66 on May 14. Our Car Show on May 15 will have a related theme. We will be featuring cars of early Route 66, from 1926 through the 1940s. Cars for the feature rows will tell the story of the development and use of Route 66, largely from its early years. ROUTE 66 PROJECT

The City Council is scheduled to vote on whether or not to accept the money to change Central Ave, Route 66, to accommodate a double center lane for buses (ART Project). The vote is supposed to take place the week of March 21. Read about the project online at the city web site. You can find addresses for Council members and the mayor online if you wish to express an opinion on the project.

UPDATE FROM SEMA

There are bills in the House (RPM) and Senate (S2659) insuring that street motor vehicles may be modified into race cars. The bills make it clear that it has always been legal to modify a street vehicle into a race car to be used on a track. Representatives Patrick McHenry(R-NC), Henry Cuellar(D-TX), Richard Hudson(R-NC), Bill Posey (R-FL) and Lee Zeldin(R-NY) are sponsoring the House Bill. The Senate Bill was introduced as a counterpart to the House Bill. The bills are intended to counteract the EPA regulation to ban modifying street cars into race cars. Contact your Representatives and Senators to voice your opinion on the bills. SEMA urges us to encourage their passage.
