The meeting was called to order at 7:33pm. All were wished a Happy New Year. A guest was **Mike Suttle** of the Porsche Club. All present received their newsletters. The treasurer reported that we are doing ok. He presented the bills and expenses from 2016 and passed out a proposed budget for 2017. Some expenses were up, and some were down; overall, our costs are rising. It was moved to accept the proposed budget. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

**Robert G.** said our web site is updated, and 350 people looked at it last week. **Jamie S.** reported we had 1709 "likes" on our facebook page.

It was also noted that a modification was needed to our bylaws to reflect the changes to our domain names. **Jim Clements** and **Bill Lemen** will be working on that.

As the Council is a non-profit group, and one of our purposes is to educate the public about our vehicles, the topic of what to do with some of our money was discussed. Several ideas were suggested to get more young people involved with the hobby: 1) A contribution of equipment to the Valencia High School Auto program; 2) Help to sponsor valve cover racing at various schools; 3) Help with model car shows and displays for kids; 4) Help the Cub Scouts with their Pinewood Derby contest. Another idea was to purchase dash plaques for Collector Car Appreciation Day. Various reps will investigate these ideas and report back at the next meeting.

Ideas were discussed about the All Clubs Picnic. **Jamie** suggested that the Council Reps take on the responsibility of organizing a crew to do the necessary jobs, instead of depending on one or two clubs to do it. The organization plan is in place already. The event proved too popular last year, and we ran out of food. It will be advertised only through member clubs this year and not be put on facebook. Everyone present seemed to want to keep Oak Flat as the location.

An announcement was made about the Supernationals being held at the Fairgrounds the following weekend, and displays will include **Bob Agnew's** shop, the Model Car Club, the Auto Artists, and the Rickshaws' sponsorship of the Ronald McDonald House.

The Museum Car Show is set for May 21. The theme will be vehicles of 1967, in honor of the Museum's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. We will get the registration forms ready to mail at the March 22 NMCCC meeting. We will start at 6:00pm, and pizza will be served for workers. Goody bags will be stuffed on May 17 with more pizza for workers. **Mark T.** presented us with bags he's already collected. The Swap Meet will be September 22-24. We will most likely send out the registration forms in June. Details will follow later.

**Bob A.** announced Spring Thaw for April 22. Reservations can be made starting March 1. He also announced plans for a 4-day tour to SW New Mexico for the first weekend in May. It will include a visit to the Santa Teresa Air Museum and a drive to Silver City. **Ron & Su R.** invited all to the annual Cruise & Schmoose on April 23; it's free. The GTO Club invited all to their annual Albuquerque Christian Children's Home show on May 13. **Michell Garcia** requested donations of valve covers that can be used for races at schools. If anyone has old valve covers that they don't need, please contact an officer or rep of the Council.
