ALL CLUBS PICNIC HISTORY

The first All Clubs Picnic announcement:

"The All Clubs Picnic will be held on August 26 (1979), Sunday, on North Route 14. It is 2.9 miles past the Crest turnoff, through San Antonito, and on the East side of the road. The Council is providing nothing except the place. There is plenty of free parking inside a fenced pasture with a gate just off the road. Shortly beyond that is a creek bed with trees, bushes, rocks and lots of room. The cows will not be in attendance. We have access to several hundred acres of private land. We can build fires for cooking, eat sandwiches, go hiking, set up games, etc. Bring a volleyball net, badminton set, horseshoes, baseballs, frisbees, or other game of your choice. It is a primitive area, i.e. no tables or johns. Meet there at around 5:00pm. There will be someone there to welcome you. It's very easy to find. Come out and meet someone you don't know and swap stories about a kind of car you've never noticed before. Bring your own supper; fires are OK if you're careful. The owner of the land just requests that we remove all trash. We'll have some bags there." We had about 30 cars drive out, ranging in age from the 1920's through the 1960's. We enjoyed our dinners, played a few horseshoes, sat under the cottonwoods on a dry creek bed and shot the bull. If you didn't bring your own chair, you sat on a rock or a blanket on the ground. The evening was quiet and peaceful, and the mountain air was cool. Cost to Council – zero. Cost to attendees – what they brought for dinner and gas to get there. Volunteers needed – one to arrange for the use of the area. Simple. This is what we call "The Good Ol' Days." – **Joyce**
