Discussions on the following subjects:

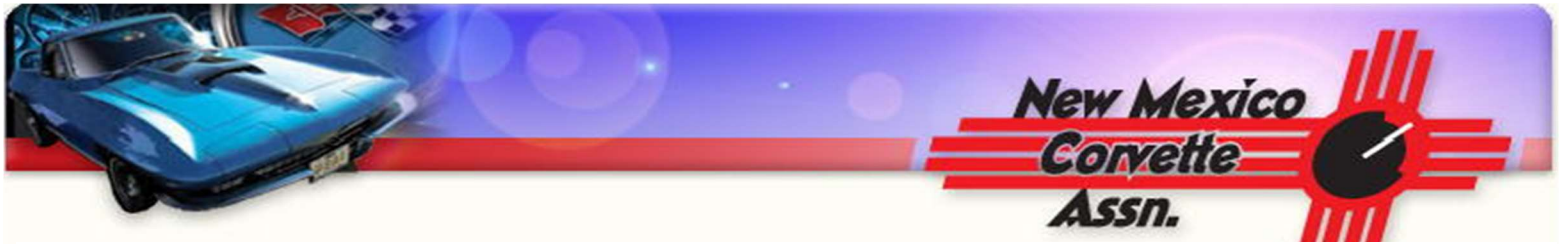
How to get more members to attend zoom meetings while restrictions remain in place
