The Owners of Plaza North would like to see the Saturday AM car meet continue but with strict guidelines. The Plaza owners will be at entrances to the event to control access and have roped off a designated "Allowable Parking Area" and there will be APD on the scene to help enforce the rules. Only customers of the businesses will be allowed to park in the parking zone restricted for businesses. Those entering will be advised of the "rules governing the event" and be required to sign a document of agreement to the rules. Upon signing the agreement, the participant will need to secure 2 sponsors from those already approved to participate, and then obtain a placard for attendance to future events.
