9/10/24

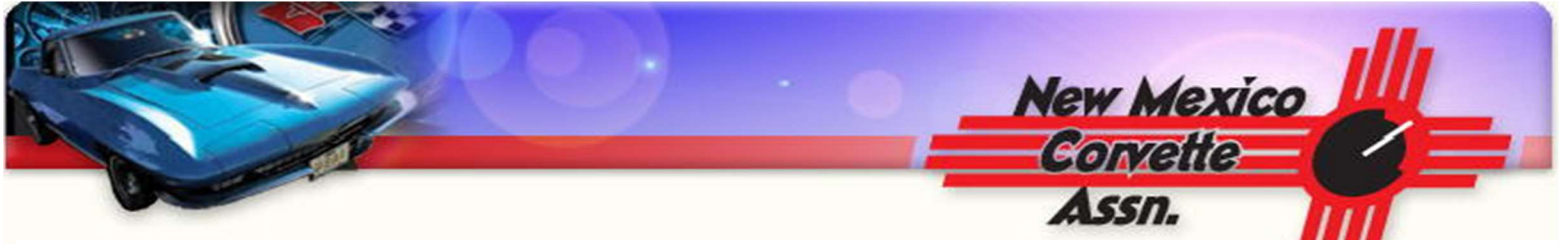
Vice President Andrew Schwebke began the meeting at 6:30 p.m., Tuesday, September 10, 2024.
